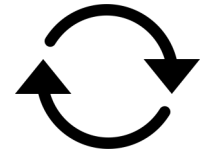

## What I already know

## Essential Knowledge

- Name and locate cities in the UK. Coastal and non coastal: Birmingham, Liverpool, Glasgow, Plymouth, Swansea, Aberdeen, Armagh.
- Use a topography map to investigate features in the UK.
- Name and locate 5 largest forests in the UK: Galloway, Kielder, New Forest, Argyll, Queen Elizabeth Forest Park.

- Use the eight points of the compass to describe a location.
