## Vocabulary

Industry	A group of businesses that makes and sell goods and products.	Engineer	A person who designs complex structures. This is a Latin word which means 'inventor, designer'.
Pottery	Pots, dishes, other things made of fired clay.	Lock	A device used for raising boats between stretches of water of different levels on canals
Tow Path	A path along a canal or river used for horses and people to tow narrow boats	Barge	A canal narrow boat
