This week we have enjoyed sharing the story 'Who's In My Family?' We have been talking about our families and creating our own family pictures.

Our forest school session went really well, we had so much fun in our puddle suits! The Blossoming Butterflies loved to explore the area and have a go at balancing and climbing on the big logs.

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RECEPTION

Reception have had a fantastic week. We have been reading the story of Funny Bones and joining in with the repeated sentences in the story. We have been learning about our different body parts and what we need to do to keep our bodies healthy. We also learnt the funny bones dance which was lots of fun! In phonics, we have learnt the graphemes ck/e/u/r we are also working really hard on our blending skills. Please see this week's homework to practice this! In maths, we have learnt all about size and capacity using key vocabulary to describe.

Next week we are starting our 3 x reading sessions in small groups. We are concentrating on book-handling skills and sitting in small groups. Very soon your child will bring home a reading book in their reading file to share at home, this will be alongside their library book which is to read for pleasure.

Please make sure ALL uniforms are clearly named. We do our best every afternoon to ensure all children go home with their belongings however as you can appreciate for 60 children this can be difficult at times.
