Thursday- Wellie Walk Day (Require Wellies to be left in school)

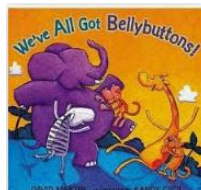
Friday- Baking/ food tasting day.
