### Learning book challenge.

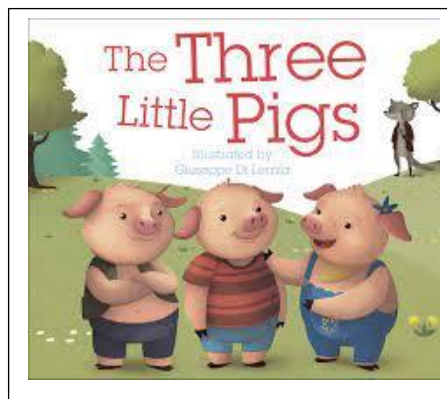
Can you be a little pig from The Three Little Pigs?
