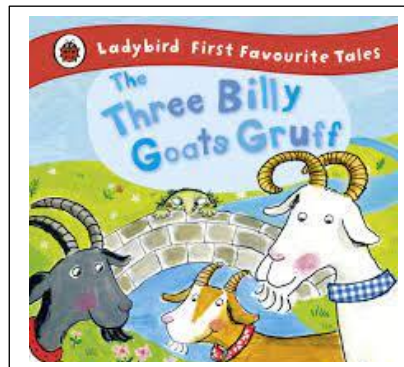
### Learning book
