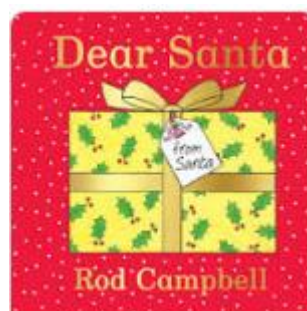
This week...
