## This week

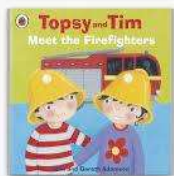
We have really enjoyed starting our superhero topic. This week we have looked at firefighters, our story of the week was Topsy and Tim meet the firefighters.
