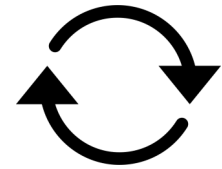

Key Vocabulary

Mountain	A large natural elevation

Lava	Hot molten rock erupting from a volcano.
