How does tourism change a place and what impact does it have?

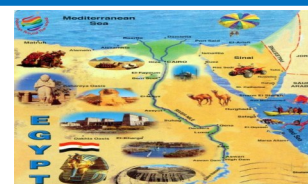
E.g. litter, noise pollution.
