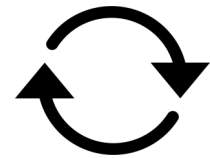

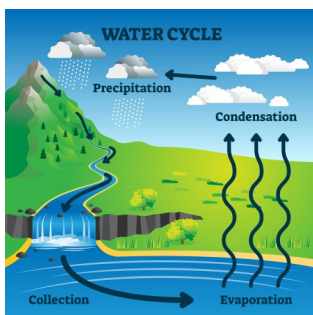

## Key Vocabulary

Evaporation	The process of turning from liquid into vapour.
Condensation	The conversion of a vapour or gas to a liquid.
Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to the land.
Source	Place where the river begins.
Channel	The flow of the river.
Bed	The bottom of the river.
Flood Plain	The area of low lying ground next to a river.
Bank	The side of the channel.
Meander	The bend in a river.
