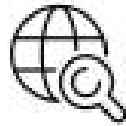

Key Vocabulary with etymology

Symbol	A drawing or photo that represents an object. Greek 'Sumbolen' means a 'mark'
Physical	Features around us not created by people—they are natural. 'Physica' is Latin for 'nature'.

Essential Knowledge

- To identify human and physical features in the school grounds.
- Understand that maps are drawn from above - 'A bird's eye view'.
- Use symbols to represent features on a map and that scale help to understand distances.
- Draw simple maps and explain the features and their purpose.
