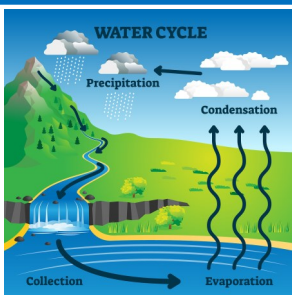

Key Vocabulary

Evaporation	The process of turning from liquid into vapour
condensation	The conversion of a vapour or gas to a liquid
Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to or condenses on the ground
Source	Place where the river begins
Channel	The part of the river that contains water
Bed	The base of the channel
Flood Plain	The area of low lying ground next to a river
Bank	The side of the channel
Meander	The bend in a river.
