Essential Knowledge

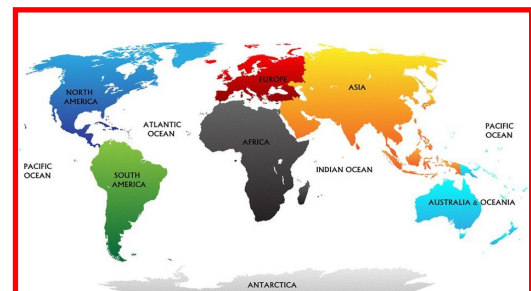
- Know the seven continents of the world: Europe, Africa, North America, South America, Asia, Antarctica and Australasia.
