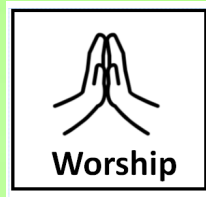

Where do Muslims go to worship?



Essential knowledge

Find out about how and when and where people worship and ask questions about why this is important to believers 1.2a

-Listen to and ask questions about stories of individuals and their relationship with God. 1.5b

- Know that Islam is the name of a religion and Muslims are the followers of this religion.
- Know that a Mosque is a place of worship for all Muslims and they pray on a prayer mat with different movement.
- Know the call to prayer is called—Adhan and Muslims pray 5 times a day when they hear the Adhan. .
- Know Muslims attend mosque on Fridays and during Eid festivals. Muslims gather in a mosque to worship and meet their fellow Muslim friends.
- Muslims believe going to the Mosque brings them closer to Allah and all their prayers are answered.

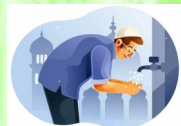
Eid is a Muslim festival YR

Key Vocabulary

Islam	Religion of peace followed by Muslims. It means submission to the will of Allah.
Muslims	Followers of the religion Islam
Allah	Muslim name for God
Mosque	A place of worship for Muslims
Worship	To pray with respect to God.
Adhan	Call to prayer—when Muslims hear the adhan they have to stop what they are doing and go and worship
Wudu	Special wash before prayer.
