Symbolism

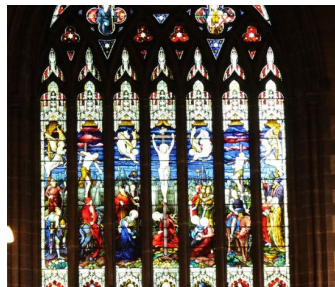
Essential knowledge

Since most of the people couldn't read and write, stained glass windows were put into the "new" church buildings to help tell Bible stories
