Wishing you all a great weekend.

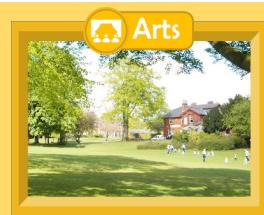

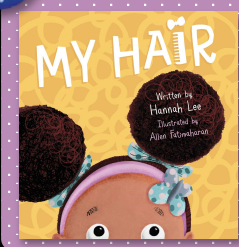
